

As a member of the Ramsey Magnet School of Science community, students are expected to wear clothes that meet uniform guidelines while attending school. The daily expectation is 100% compliance. All uniforms must be clean, free from holes, and in good condition. If a student chooses to dress inappropriately, parents will be contacted. The student will change into appropriate clothes and be reminded about the uniform guidelines. Additional violations will be subject to disciplinary action.

#### Uniform Tops:

Uniform shirts consist of a plain, solid-colored, long or short sleeved shirt or sweatshirt with the Ramsey logo on the left upper chest corner. Brand names and logos must not be visible. Students can choose any colors they desire. The uniform guidelines do not prohibit students from wearing coats, jackets, sweaters, or other appropriate outer garments as needed for weather conditions. If a student desires to wear an outer garment (sweater, vest, or sweatshirt) in the building, it must have a visible logo.

#### Special Chorus:

Special Chorus will have shirts for performance events. To demonstrate the concepts of community, pride, and respect, students must be dressed in their special chorus uniform to participate in performance events.

#### Uniform Bottoms:

Boys: Jeans; solid navy, black, or khaki colored pants; shorts. No sweatpants or running pants permitted.

Girls: Jeans; solid navy, black, or khaki colored pants; shorts; skirts; skorts; or capris. No sweatpants or running pants permitted.
