

Lutheran Academy of the Master Uniform Policy 2011-12

- The philosophy behind having a uniform is to look the same, to be one body of students working and learning together. All students are required to wear **only approved uniform options** to school. If it isn't on the list, it is **not** to be worn.
- For all **approved uniform options**, including chapel wear, please visit the following:

- All items not purchased from the approved vendors must be brought to the LAM office for approval. Required Attire will logo items purchased from other locations but they do require an approval slip from the LAM office to do so.

Chapel Uniform

- A chapel uniform is required on Thursdays for Pre-kindergarteners through fifth graders – this includes the Bridge class. (Lamb preschoolers do not attend chapel so those items listed are *optional*, however these students must also be in uniform each day.)
- Chapel uniform items may be worn on non-chapel days as well.
- Chapel uniforms are required for all school field trips and performances unless the principal grants special permission.
- Chapel items with an asterick (*) can only be purchased from Spokane Uniform House or Required Attire.

Uniform Requirements

Belts – Belts should be worn by older students. Shirts should be tucked in on chapel days.

Boots – Snow Boots are the *only* boots allowed; no dress boots or cowboy boots. Snow Boots are to be worn to and from school and at recess but regular shoes must be worn inside.

Fleece Vest or Jacket (Logoed)

- Hunter green, navy, or royal blue

Hair Accessories - All hair accessories must be in school colors

- Hunter green, navy, royal blue, or white

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Jackets & Sweaters – Only items listed on the uniform policy may be worn indoors during the school day. Students may **not** wear non-uniform clothing during school hours.

Jumper – Navy, uniform style (Logoed)

Pants – Pleated or flat front uniform pant (cotton/blend only – no polyester, cargo, corduroy, or embellishments)

- Navy

Polo – short or long sleeve (Logoed)

- Hunter green, navy, royal blue, or white

Shoes – Shoes can have ties, buckles or Velcro closures and need to be closed toe. Brightly colored character or light-up shoes, sandals, flip flops, or pumps are not allowed. Shoes with laces must be tied.

- Plain dark shoes are preferred. If not available, clean plain white shoes are acceptable.

Shoes for P.E. - (Grades K through 5th)

- Plain dark *running* shoes are preferred but clean plain white *running* shoes are acceptable.
- No skirts or jumpers on PE days.

Socks - (Boys)

- Solid dark or solid white

Socks & Tights - (Girls)

- No leggings.
- Solid navy or solid white

Shorts, Skirt, & Skort – Uniform style (cotton twill - no polyester, cargo, corduroy, or embellishments). No bare legs from November through March 15th.

- Navy

Sweatshirt – crew neck style only. (Logoed)

- Hunter green, navy, or royal blue

Turtleneck – standard or mock (Logoed)

- Hunter green, navy, or white

Important Reminders

- Be sure to LABEL all uniform items that the kids “shed” throughout the day.
- Only items on this list will be approved for logoing. If items are not purchased from one of the approved sources, they may not be approved for logoing. Please keep items in a returnable condition until approved.
- Skirts and jumpers must be no shorter than 1 inch above the bent knee at the back of the leg.
- All uniform items should be checked regularly for rips, holes, stains and general appearance. Baggy or low fitting styles are not acceptable. Torn or worn out styles are not acceptable
- Every effort has been made to be clear; however, if an interpretation is to be made, the school administration will have the final say.
